The O'Brien County Sheriff's Office is investigating two burglaries and an attempted burglary to businesses in the city of Primghar, Iowa. The burglaries are believed to have occurred on Saturday night May 12, 2012 and into the early morning hours of Sunday May 13, 2012. The suspect or suspects gained entry into the Pizza Ranch Restaurant and the Primghar Library and stole an undisclosed amount of cash. Also during this same time frame the suspect or suspects attempted to gain entry into Baxterz Bar & Grill in Primghar but were unsuccessful.

The Crime Dusters program is offering a **\$200 reward** to anyone who provides information on this crime that leads to the arrest and conviction of the offenders.

2. Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, 124.414, Code of Iowa

Roger and Lana Vanden Brink were booked and later posted a \$1,000 bond and will appear in court at a later date.

Caveat: *All persons are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.*
