RIGHT TO REPORT

If you, or someone you know, are experiencing sexual abuse or sexual harassment in the O'Brien County Jail, we want to know. We want you to report any incidents right away! Why?

- We want to keep YOU safe; it is our job! It is your right to be free from sexual abuse and sexual harassment
- We want to conduct an investigation of the reported incident.
- We want to hold the perpetrator accountable for his/her actions.
- We want to provide YOU with relevant information and support services.

HOW TO REPORT

O'Brien County Jail offers multiple ways to report sexual abuse and sexual harassment. Reports can be made anonymously in any of the following methods.

- Report to any staff, volunteer, contractor, or medical or mental health staff or call Family Crisis Center (800) 382-5603 Citizen Aid (Ombudsman) (515) 281-3592.
- By submitting a grievance, request form, or medical request.
- Report to Thomas Raymond Jail Supervisor, who is the PREA Coordinator/Compliance Manager.
- Tell a family member, friend, legal counsel, or anyone else outside the facility. They may report on your behalf by calling O'Brien County Jail (712) 957-5245 or the O'Brien County Sheriff's Office (712) 757-3415
- You may submit a report on behalf of an inmate, or someone at the facility can report for you using the ways listed here.

VICTIM SUPPORT SERVICES
