On November 23, 2016 at approximately 8:30pm the Sanborn Police Department conducted a traffic stop with a white Pontiac Grand Prix in the Casey's General Store parking lot in Sanborn. During the traffic stop the driver, identified as Saverio Marino, decided to speed away from the stop. Officer's pursued the subject through O'Brien County and part of Clay County, including the communities of Sheldon, Sanborn, and Hartley. The pursuit was terminated by officers due to the speed and public safety concerns.

On December 7, 2016 at 11:02 PM, Saverio Marino was arrested without incident at a residence in Paullina, IA on numerous warrants including Eluding, Reckless Driving, and Interference with Official Acts, Driving While Revoked, Speeding, and four Stop Sign violations for a total bond of \$4,400 cash or surety.

Saverio Marino was also arrested on three other O'Brien county bond revocation warrants that stemmed from two other incidents where Marino attempted to elude police. The previous incidents with Marino involved a stolen motorcycle, drug, and firearm violations. Marino's total bond is currently \$24,100 cash. The investigation continues and more charges are expected.

Marino was booked into the O'Brien County Jail. Agencies involved in the pursuit that occurred on November 23, 2016 and the arrest of Saverio Marino included O'Brien County Sheriff's Office, Paullina Police Department, Sanborn Police Department, Sheldon Police Department, Hartley Police Department, Clay County Sheriff's Office, and the Iowa State Patrol.
