

The O'Brien County Sheriff's Office is investigating an accident involving farm related equipment that occurred at the Archer Co-op Grain Company, 112 Cherokee Ave., Archer, Iowa.

FRANCESCA M. FEEKES, a 20 year old intern at the Archer Co-op was injured when she became entangled in a PTO shaft on a tender truck at the Co-op. She was transported by Archer ambulance to Sheldon Sanford Medical Center with serious injuries.

The call was received at the sheriff's office on May 17, 2017 at 4:19 p.m. The original information was that someone was caught in an auger. The Archer Fire and Ambulance were dispatched to the scene. Sheldon Fire Department was also dispatched to assist with extrication. The Sheldon Fire Department was told to disregard when it was determined that no extrication was required.

O'Brien County Sheriff's Office and O'Brien County EMA also responded to the call.
