An O'Brien County Sheriff's Deputy has arrested **JARROD JAY BANDOW**, age 42, who was operating a 2003 Chevy S10 pickup that had been reported stolen in Estherville, Iowa.

The deputy observed the stolen pickup on highway 18 in Sheldon and attempted to make a stop. The driver failed to stop, leading the deputy north on highway 60, at times traveling the wrong direction on the four-way highway.

Bandow was eventually taken into custody in George, Iowa where he exited the moving vehicle and was tackled by an Iowa Highway Trooper after a brief foot pursuit. The vehicle came to rest in a snow bank and received no damage. There were no injuries as a result of the arrest.

Bandow is being held in the O'Brien County Jail on a \$5,000 bond charged with: two counts of driving under suspension; violating one-way traffic; reckless driving, eluding (a class D felony); stop sign and speeding. A charge of OWI may be filed pending lab results. Sheriff's officers from Osceola County and Lyon County assisted with the arrest along with officers of the Iowa State Patrol.

There are also outstanding warrants for Bandow from Osceola County for failure to appear on a theft in the 5th charge. Emmet County has a warrant for contempt-failure to pay on an assault with intent to commit sexual abuse, and Clay County has a warrant for possession of drug paraphernalia
