The O'Brien County Sheriff is reporting that on Saturday, April 24, 2021 at approximately 9:49AM, an O'Brien County Deputy Sheriff made a traffic stop on a 1995 Chevy pickup truck registered to Jennifer Jones of Paullina, Iowa. The traffic stop occurred in the 3100 mile of McKinley Ave, Sheldon and was conducted due to traffic offenses.

The deputy found the driver and only occupant of the truck to be 45-year-old, Daniel Ryan Trevino of Hartley Iowa. Further investigation uncovered drug paraphernalia inside the truck and Trevino was arrested for possession of drug paraphernalia, 124.414.

The pickup truck was towed and the O'Brien County K9, Ella, conducted a K9 search and indicated that there was illegal controlled substance within the pickup truck. A search warrant was obtained and approximately 112 grams of crystal methamphetamine were located and seized.

This investigation is ongoing and further search warrants and arrests are pending.

Daniel Trevino has been charged with the following and is being held in the O'Brien County Jail on a \$10,000.00 bond.

Possession of Methamphetamine with the Intent to Deliver: A class "B" felony.

Failure to Affix a Drug Tax Stamp: A class "D" felony.

Possession of methamphetamine 2nd offense: An Aggravated Misdemeanor.

Possession of Drug Paraphernalia: A Simple Misdemeanor.

Failure to have proof of insurance; A Simple Misdemeanor.

Driving left of Center: A Simple Misdemeanor.

Assisting the O'Brien County Sheriff's Office with this investigation is the Clay County Sheriff's Office and the Iowa Great Lakes Task Force.

Everyone charged with a criminal offence shall have the right to be presumed innocent until proved guilty according to the law.
