Narrative

Unit 1 was driving westbound on 330th St. It appears as though Unit 1 did not stop for the stop sign at the intersection of 330th St and Roosevelt Ave. After running the stop sign, Unit 1 continued westbound onto 330th St which turns into gravel west of Roosevelt Ave. The driver of Unit 1 then lost control of the vehicle and ran off of the roadway to the right. Unit 1 then rolled at least one and a half times. The driver was unable to speak after the accident and she was transported to the Sanford Sheldon Hospital. The driver was then transferred to the Sanford Sioux Falls Hospital. Unit 1 sustained approximately \$12000 worth of damage.
